LEAGUE DESCRIPTIONS

League formats and times are subject to change.

Men's Leagues

Senior Men's Mondays and Wednesday @ 1:00pm

These are two separate day leagues taking place on Monday and Wednesday, with several players participating in both. Participants must be 55+ to participate as of Nov 1, 2021. Pick-up league.

Businessmen's Monday @ 5:15pm

This is a dinner league with most of the curlers enjoying a post-game dinner on the last Monday of each draw. Dinner is not mandatory nor is it included in membership fees. Entry is by team.

Men's Monday Monday @ 7:30pm

This is a single entry league with teams changed 2 or 3 times through the season. A great league for newer curlers, and a way to curl with several different players over the year.

Men's Recreational Tuesday @ 9:00pm

This is a fun league and a great place for new curlers. All teams qualify for year-end play-downs. Entry is by team. Drawmasters would be happy to help individuals looking for a team.

Ladies' Leagues

Afternoon Ladies Tuesday @ 1:00pm

For women who wish to curl daytime. The regular ice time is 1:00 pm but numbers sometimes warrant a morning draw as well.

Evening Ladies Tuesday @ 6:45pm

A great ladies league with teams generally changed 3 times through the course of the season and trophies for each draw.

Businesswomen Thursday @ 4:45pm

This is a great social league with most players staying for dinner following play once monthly.

Mixed Leagues

Mixed Wednesday Wednesday @ 6:45pm & 9:00pm

This is a team entry league, so round up your foursome for the season.

Thursday Afternoon Mixed Thursday @ 1:00pm

Pick-up league open to mixed teams. Show up and play!

Open Thursday Thursday @ 7:00pm & 9:00pm

This is our most competitive league, and teams may be any combination of men and women.

Friday Mixed Friday @ 6:30pm & 8:45pm

This is a league that nicely balances the social and competitive aspects of the game. Teams are changed 2 times through the season— a great way to make new friends.

Instructional Wednesday @ 5:00pm

Group instruction covering the basics of all things curling. No equipment necessary. A fun way to learn the game and meet new people!

Junior

There is potential for the addition of Sunday junior times should participation numbers permit.

Little Rocks (5-9) Tuesday (Nov. 2 to Feb. 1)

This program will provide participants with an introduction to the sport of curling. Including is 12 weeks of instruction and game simulation.

Learn to Curl (9-14) Tuesday (Nov. 2 to Dec. 7)

6 weeks of instruction focusing on equipment, curling delivery and brushing. Game simulation and pizza party at the end of the program.

Junior Developmental (10-18) Tuesday (Nov. 2 to Mar. 1)

This program is designed for graduates of Learn to Curl. Participants will learn to further develop delivery and brushing skills, introduction of game strategy, and develop teams to play in house league. Pizza Party at the end of the program.
